HOW DO PARTICIPANTS WIN AWARDS & PRIZES AT THE ATLANTIC NATIONALS?

All Atlantic Nationals award categories are judged by participant volunteers.

Major prizes are awarded by random draw.

The Atlantic Nationals "Top 25"

"Sunday Main Stage"

The Top 25" will be chosen by a Team of dedicated Judges who look at the cars during the weekend. The Committee then tabulates the results based on participant popularity and the 25 vehicles receiving the most judges votes are picked for the Atlantic Nationals "Top 25" Awards

The Atlantic Nationals Safety Awards

"Don't forget the Safety Lanes"

The Atlantic Nationals Safety Awards are broken into two categories. "Top 10 Pre 1949" and Top 10 Post 1948". In order to be eligible for these Awards, the vehicle must first pass a Atlantic Nationals Safety Inspection. The Inspection area is manned by volunteers who inspect the vehicle to ensure that it is safe, based on a criteria set out by the Atlantic Nationals Safety Committee. Once a car passes the inspection and receives its safety sticker, it can proceed to a "Drive-Thru Judging Area" where volunteer judges, picked from the show participants, rate the vehicles in a number of categories to determine a score as a percentage of 100 points. The judges score cards are compared and the top ten scores in each category go on to receive these Awards.

Sponsor Awards "Presented at the Dance"

Each of the Atlantic National's major sponsors have an award that is given to a vehicle that they pick as their favorite. The Sponsor's on-site representative or their designate chooses the vehicle for the award and presents the winner to the awards coordinator for presentation. Normally a Sponsor's representative presents a plaque at the award ceremony.

NSRA Awards "Sunday Main Stage"

The National Street Rod Association (NSRA) representatives choose 2 vehicles to receive the Atlantic Nationals NSRA Awards. The winners of these awards must have a <u>valid CSRA/NSRA Safety Sticker</u>.

Major Prizes "Sunday Main Stage"

A number of major prizes are given away at the Atlantic Nationals Awards Ceremony. These prizes are donated by our major sponsors and are awarded when a participants name is picked by random draw. The winners of these awards must be registered for the entire weekend, (full price admission), be on site at the ceremony to claim the prize and must have a legitimate title to the vehicle they have entered in the event.

Give-Away Prizes "Prize Trailer"

Throughout the event, hundreds of prizes are given away by random participant number draw. All winning numbers are recorded on a board at the awards trailer in the vendor area.
